What is a Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM)?

The SHSM program offers students the opportunity to explore a specific area or career of interest and to acquire the skills and experience that will assist them in their post secondary pathway: Apprenticeship Training, College, University and the Work Place.

Each SHSM program includes:

1. Eight to Ten Bundled Senior Credits, including four Major Sector Credits
2. Sector Recognized Certifications and Safety Awareness Training
3. Experiential Learning
4. Use of the ONTARIO SKILLS PASSPORT
5. "REACH AHEAD" Experiences

Students in the SHSM Programs have the opportunity to:

- Customize their secondary school education to suit their interests and talents through a specialized bundle of credits
- Explore, identify and refine career goals
- Make informed decisions regarding postsecondary education destinations
- Access resource, equipment and expertise that may not be available in their home secondary school
- Receive a special SHSM red seal designation on their diplomas
- Network with potential employers
