Bus Passes will be available for students if required.

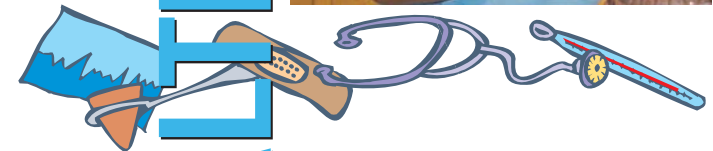
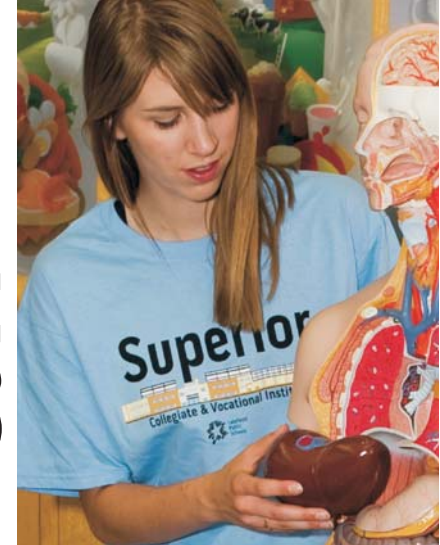

Students who are interested in a career in the Health Care sector (Aboriginal Early Childhood Education Worker, Child and Youth Worker, Fire and Police Foundations, Massage Therapist, Paramedic, Ultrasound Technician, Dentist, Nurse, Nutritionist, Physical Therapist, etc.) will:

**Achieve a 'bundle' of 9 Grade 11 and Grade 12 credits for a work, apprenticeship, college or university pathway** (flexible)

(Health Care Sector-Specific)

**Achieve up to 7 sector-recognized certifications and training**

- **Optional** (conflict resolution, safe body mechanics, medical terminology, lab practices, etc.)

**Gain experiential learning in the student's post secondary destination/career choice within the health care sector**

**Develop essential skills and work habits required in the health care, with documentation in the Ontario Skills Passport**

Students who participate in the Health & Wellness– Specialist High Skills Major will customize their secondary education to suit their interests and talents while meeting graduation requirements. Students who successfully complete all elements of the program will receive the Specialist High Skills Major designation on their Ontario Secondary School diploma. The first year of certification will be 2010.

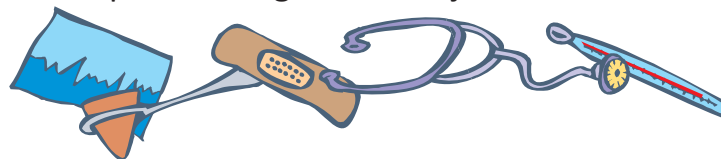
