ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

The ECE Dual Credit program is a one semester program that combines co-op education with dual credits, and much more:

- 2 Sheridan ECE college level courses
- 2 high school dual credits (earned by successfully completing the Sheridan courses)
- 2 high school co-op credits
- Certification in Standard First Aid, Infant, Child and Adult CPR, and WHMIS
- And you will gain the skills, knowledge, and experience to prepare for the start of a career working with children

You will be enrolled in a co-op program and placed in a JK/SK classroom or child care centre working with trained ECE professionals for hands on experience integrating theory into best practices. During this semester, you will also be attending classes at Sheridan College to start working towards your ECE diploma. You will be receiving dual credits for these courses.
