### Program Overview:

The concentrated OYAP/SHSM program offers first hand training in all four career pathway destinations, Apprenticeship, College, University and the Workplace, with Certifications in WHMIS, Standard First Aid, Adult CPR, and additional beneficial industry certifications.

This program will enable students to be prepared for industry identified knowledge, skills and certifications, as well as "reach ahead" and "on the job" learning opportunities focused within the transportation service industry. Students will be able to pursue a transportation apprenticeship, head to the workplace, enroll in college, or pursue university studies in the transportation industry.

### Students will:

- be exposed to skilled trades and professional areas such as truck and coach, and motorcycle marine or in automotive engineering or design.
- be trained, using the latest technologies in industry
- establish contacts with industry leaders, learn first hand the skills that are required to be job ready on day one
- have the opportunity to earn dual-credits, accelerating your certification process

- 1 Math Credit
- 1 Credit in Science or Business
