Formerly Sundial and Mattamy Homes

- **Halton Home Builders' Program** is a partnership with a Home Builder in the Halton region.
Two former partners were Sundial Homes and Mattamy Homes
- **Halton Home Builders' Program** is a four credit one semester program, providing students with a unique hands-on opportunity to experience the many skills and trades available in the home building industry, while building a house from the ground up.
- To date this program has served more than 170 students from 21 schools in two school boards.
- This co-operative educational partnership is a highly successful example of the educational rewards that can be achieved when the private sector and district school boards work together to empower students with hands-on learning opportunities.
- This program has run successfully in Halton since September 1998.
- Senior students from all High Schools in Halton are eligible to participate in the program.
- Students construct a new home from the ground up and receive four credits for their participation. Two construction and two Co-op credits.
- This program provides students with a chance to see the many job opportunities available to them in the home building construction industry.
- It also provides students with the opportunity to work half days as a Co-op student with one or two of a wide variety of possible construction trades or construction jobs.
- It prepares students for lucrative careers in both management and trades.
- Homes built by students meet the industry and government standards and are sold on completion.
- Some participating Halton students have gone on to university, college, and apprenticeship as well as directly into the work force upon completion of this program.
